Dr. Jawale also spoke on 'nuclear and innovation' at the International Youth Nuclear Congress at Sydney, Australia (March 2020). She is an active member of International Nuclear Law Association and Indian Nuclear Law Association since 2017. She is also a member of Indian Society of Criminology.
